umpiring when he turned 16 to make a little extra cash.

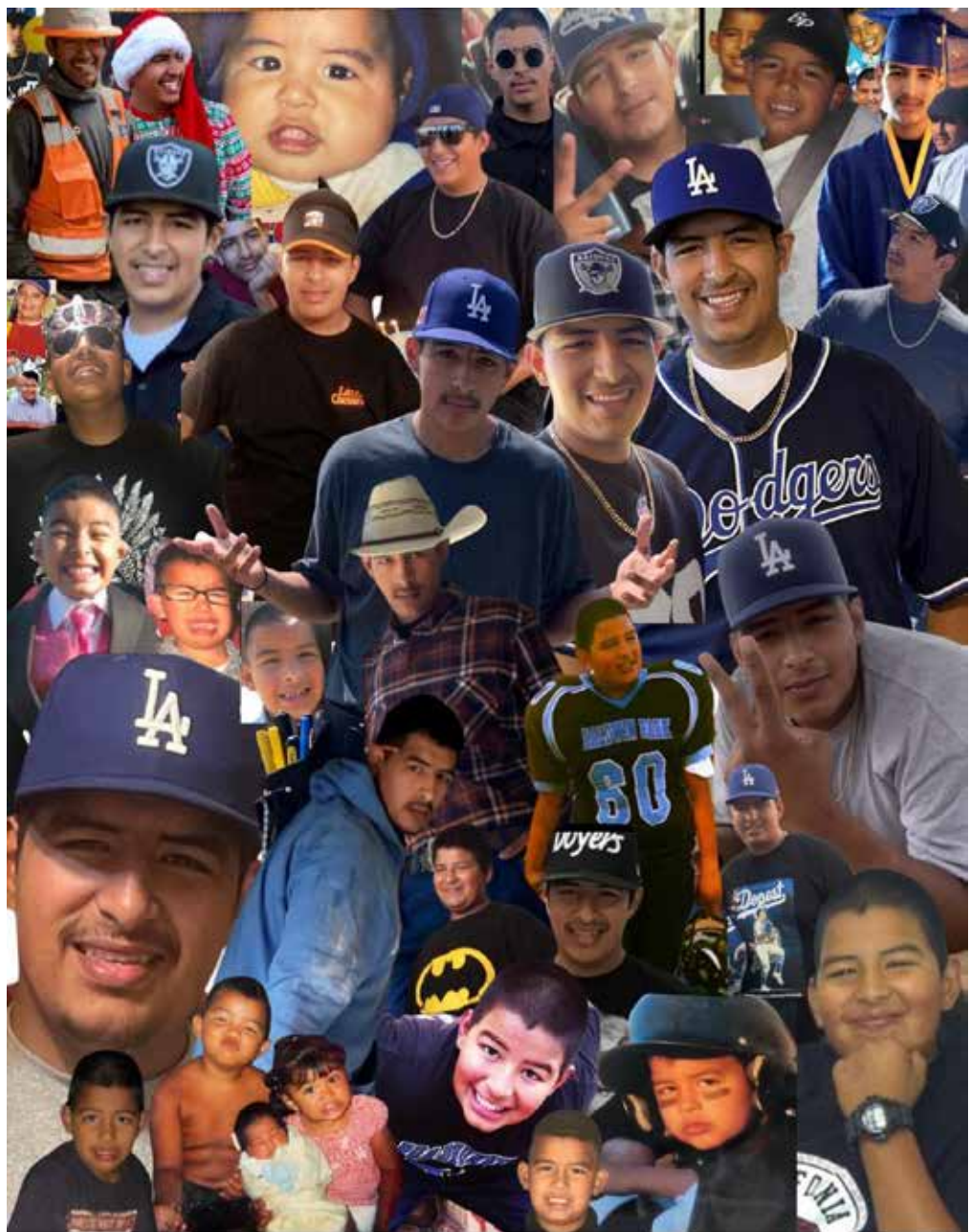
Graduated from Sierra High School in Azusa high school on June 9, 2020.

till the day he passed away.

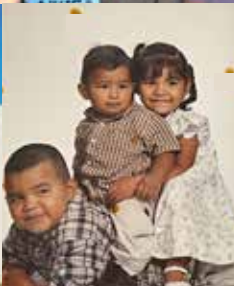
Rigo had a heart of gold. He was quiet a character and was a funny guy.
